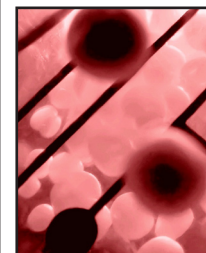
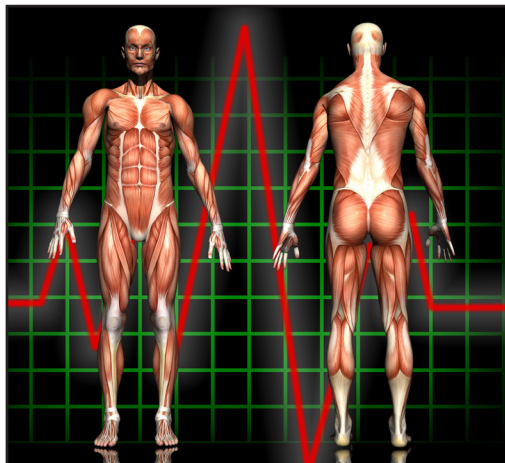
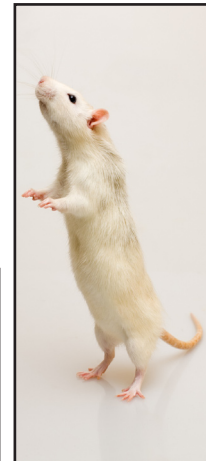
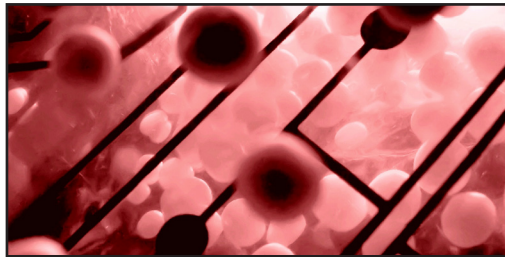
Applications for these funded courses are welcome from undergraduate students, postgraduate and post-doctoral researchers currently registered with, or employed by UK Universities.
